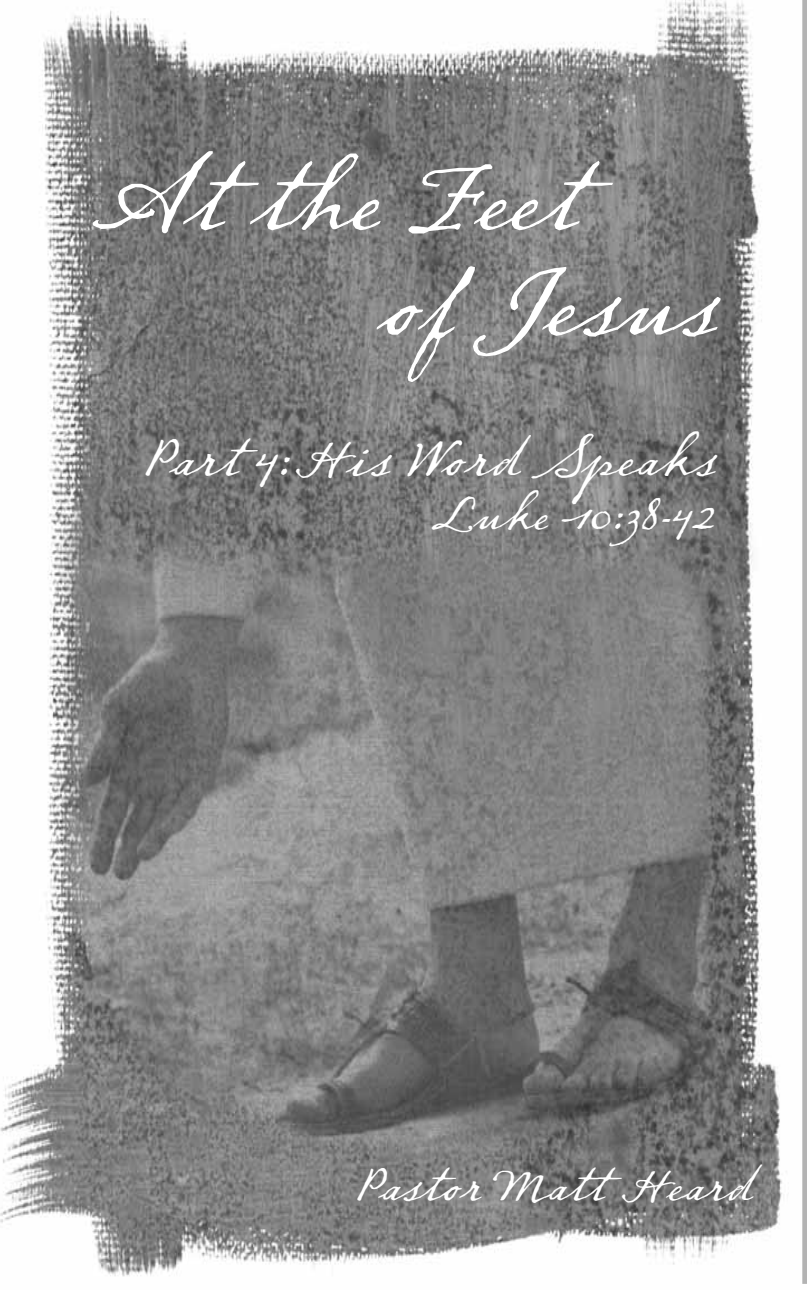

At the Feet of Jesus

Part 4: His Word Speaks **Luke 10:38-42**

In a Palestinian village a couple of thousand years ago, something happened which was both simple and extraordinary. In the simplicity of an ordinary event, an extraordinary lesson unfolded—a lesson that would wind its way over the course of history and through the lives of countless Christ-followers, ultimately finding its way to the doorstep of your life. It's a lesson that, when embraced, can change the cadence of a person's journey.

It was in the town of Bethany, which was located just east of Jerusalem, where two sisters lived: Martha and Mary. Jesus of Nazareth, the great Rabbi from Galilee, was paying a visit to their home. In the midst of the frenzy of activity which was understandably surrounding the occasion, Mary—because of both an awe she had for Jesus and a need she sensed in her own heart—made a decision. She decided to sit at the feet of Jesus and open up her heart in submission to Him. Jesus, the master Rabbi, seized the teachable moment and affirmed Mary for her decision. She could have continued to accelerate her pace of preparations and activity, consequently missing the opportunity before her. But she didn't.

Every one of us faces a similar decision every day of our lives. Too often, we let the loudness of superficial priorities drown out the substantive but quieter sound of what's really important in life. We let the frenzy of mere activity overwhelm the quest for Truth. As a result, we remain superficial, shallow and colorless in the way we live our lives.

Richard Foster begins his book on the spiritual disciplines (*Celebration of Discipline*) with this observation: "Superficiality is the curse of our age...The desperate need today is not for a greater number of intelligent people, or gifted people, but for deep people."

At Woodmen Valley Chapel, we are pursuing that depth together: substance that enables us to relevantly engage with real life. A ship can only effectively and enjoyably (and "relevantly") sail into a turbulent culture with the stability enabled by a strong keel. The keel of your journey is the substance of your walk with Christ, who is the Way and the Truth. It's a substance that is more than the mere academic accumulation of religious facts. It's a substance that arises from authentically engaging our individual life stories with spiritual Truth: both the written Word (Scripture) and the living Word (Jesus). Bottom line, it's a substance that arises from intimacy with Jesus Christ.

We all hunger for that deeper place. A place where we'll taste meaning. Transformation. Strength. Forgiveness. Hope. Companionship. Peace. Fulfillment. Intimacy. Those and many, many more treasures can only be found at the feet of Jesus. This series is an opportunity for you to listen to the needs of your own heart and allow your amazement over who God is and what He does to compel you to bring your need to the feet of Jesus. There, instead of dust, you'll find direction...

This whole process started with a decision to be *still*. Then we looked at what happens in the stillness...there will be a posture of *submission* (Mary *sat at the Lord's feet*). Last week we discovered there will also be *silence*. In verse 39 we find that Mary was silent at Christ's feet because she was *listening to what he said*. Today, we continue to listen.

As I am learning to listen to the Word of God, I'll adopt the following practices:
