FINDING GOD IN THE LAND OF NARNIA

Guest Speaker: Kurt Bruner

Kurt Bruner is the co-author with Jim Ware of the best-selling book *Finding God in the Land of Narnia*. He also served as Production Executive over the Focus on the Family Radio Theatre dramatization of all seven Narnia tales.

In anticipation of Walden Media and Walt Disney's release of the film *The Lion, The Witch and the Wardrobe*—this special service is designed to inspire your family to dive into the world and worldview of C.S. Lewis as experienced through his seven Chronicles of Narnia. We encourage children of all ages to read or listen to the entire series in order to relive these wonderful stories laced with Christian themes.

In addition, we have provided the following Family Night activities for parents to do with their children during the next few weeks as a way of leveraging their excitement over the movie to more deeply impact their hearts with the Gospel message.

Family Night #1: Turkish Delight

➤ Theme: The Snare of Sin

➤ Reading: *Finding God in the Land of Narnia* (Chapter 5: Turkish Delight)

➤ Scriptures: Proverbs 20:17, Ephesians 6:11, I Peter 5:8

➤ Activity: Discuss what Ephesians 6:11 describes as the “schemes” or “snares” of Satan. Plan an activity in which your children set various traps and watch how they catch their prey. You can use a shoebox propped up with a pencil attached to a long string—inviting the child to attempt to retrieve a piece of candy (i.e. “Turkish Delight”) as you try to trap them. It might be even more fun for your child to control the trap as mom or dad try to grab the candy. Next, show children how a mouse trap works—using a pencil to trigger the deadly spring. The activity goal is to help the children understand that Satan will use what we like (candy, etc.) to lure us in and trap us because his true goal is to kill and destroy as stated in I Peter 5:8.

Family Night #2: Deep Magic

➤ Theme: Redemption

➤ Reading: *Finding God in the Land of Narnia* (Chapter 8: Deep and Deeper Magic)

➤ Scriptures: Romans 3:23, Romans 6:23

➤ Activity #1: Do a cheap card trick with your child—such as asking them to pick a card and place it in the middle of your split deck. Keeping track of where they placed the card—retrieve it with great fanfare as if you are a mighty magician. Most children will quickly perceive the trick—and if they don't you should explain it to them. Explain to the child that the “magic” of condemnation is based upon the stern demands of the law (Romans 3:23).

➤ Activity #2: Stand at the top of the stairs while your children remain at the bottom. Tell them you represent God in heaven—and that you want them to be with you. Tell them they must figure out how to get to where you are without touching the stairs or touching the railing. If they don't figure it out, let them in on the secret. If you have a spouse or older sibling present, ask them to whisper in the child's ear “Ask Dad/Mom to come down the stairs and carry you up them.” Explain to the child/children that, like Edmund, there is nothing we can do to save ourselves because the law demands perfection. That is why Jesus came down from heaven and paid the price for our salvation. (Romans 6:23)
