The Holy Spirit Works Through You To...

Administration – Organize and execute plans to accomplish ministry goals.

Apostleship – Start, revitalize or reengineer a ministry to increase effectiveness.

Craftsmanship – Creatively design and/or construct items to be used for ministry.

Creative Communication – Use the arts to communicate the message of Christ.

Discernment – Keen ability to distinguish between truth and error.

Evangelism – Build relationships with unbelievers and engage them in spiritual conversations that helps them move toward a personal relationship with Jesus.

Exhortation – Encourage and strengthen people through words of comfort, inspiration and reassurance.

Faith – Bold, peaceful, confidence in God that assures people of God's sovereignty.

Giving – Joy in contributing money and resources to advance ministry purposes.

Healing – Pray, touch or speak words that bring spiritual, physical or emotional healing to others.

Helps – Support a ministry project or another person by assisting in the accomplishment of ministry tasks.

Hospitality – Create a comfortable environment through food, housing or relationships.

Intercession – Pray on behalf of others in response to God's prompting.

Interpretation – Make known to the body a message that was spoken in an unknown language.

Knowledge – Bring truth to the church by revealing critical information or biblical insight.

Leadership – Cast vision, motivate and build teams to advance God's purposes.

Mercy – Extending compassion to the poor and hurting so that they may experience God in practical ways.

Miracles – Demonstrate God's authority through supernatural interventions that bring glory to God.

Prophecy – Provide guidance to others by proclaiming truth that causes correction or repentance.

Shepherding – Nurture, care for and guide people toward spiritual maturity.

Teaching – Ability to understand and clearly explain biblical truth to help others apply it to their lives and grow in their faith walk.

Tongues – Speak, worship or pray in a language unknown to the speaker for the purpose of prayer or to deliver a message to the body.

Wisdom – Apply spiritual truth effectively to meet a need in a specific situation.
