

Take It Home Events

“Take It Home Events” are workshops for the parents and child where the parents and child come together to learn a new faith skill that they can continue developing in the home. Parents are asked to come one time per year per age of their child(ren).

The events are 30-45 minutes long and include a time of worship, teaching, craft, parent/child discussion (depending upon the age of the child) and a take home resource. The resource is a tool that will enable families to continue what they have learned at home.

These will take place on the First Saturday at 7:00pm at Woodmen Heights in Mod 6; on the First Sunday at 8:45am at Rockrimmon in Noah’s Ark in room 206 for early childhood ages, in room 108 in the Community Center for elementary ages.

Infants	Dedication	Classes are May (for May and June), September, February and November.	A partnership begins with families as they dedicate their children and begin passing on the faith to future generations
1 year olds	Family Blessing		To establish a routine for parents of praying a blessing over their children daily
2 year olds	Family Nights and Devotions		To lead the family in developing a routine of Family Nights and devotions
3 year olds	Prayer		Families are taught about prayer and how to pray with their children

4 year olds	The Church	Children are taken on a tour of the church and learn about our facilities
Kindergarten	My First Bible	The children receive a Bible and learn the story of the Bible
1st Graders	Family Service	The family experiences the joy of doing a service project together and learn ways they can continue to serve in the community and the world
2nd Graders	Journaling	What can we learn about the Lord and what can we learn about ourselves through journaling?
3rd Graders	Worship	Children are taught what worship is and how we worship
4th Graders	Parents, Kids and \$\$	Kids begin to learn about finance and the meaning and importance of tithes and offerings
5 th Grade	Music, Media and Me	We discuss the role of music and media play in shaping our values and help establish appropriate boundaries.
